The Autumn Meeting will take place on Sunday, 4th September 2011 over 36 holes at Cathkin Braes Golf Club, under Strokeplay conditions and in accordance with the Rules of Golf, the Local Rules of the Club and the Glasgow Golf Union.

Entry is restricted to players whose nominated 'Home Club' is affiliated, as a 'course-owning' club, to the Glasgow Golf Union and have a **handicap not exceeding 6 strokes** from scratch. In the event of a tie after 36 holes, placings will be decided on the basis of second round scores, then countback over the last 9, last 6 holes etc.

The 15 competitors with the lowest aggregate scratch scores, together with the current champion, will qualify for the Match Play Championship which will be played over Cathkin Braes on the undernoted dates (and times).

**No practice round facilities are available nor are caddies permitted in the strokeplay event.**

**The use of electronic devices is only permitted for the measurement of distance .**
