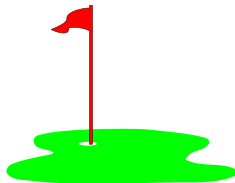

The Annual Competition for the Glasgow Golf Union Boys' Strokeplay Championship will take place on Monday, 11th July, 2011 under strokeplay conditions and in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Cathcart Castle Golf Club and the Glasgow Golf Union. The competition will be over 36 holes and the competitor returning the lowest scratch score will be awarded the Strokeplay Trophy. In the event of a tie the trophy will be held jointly. Prizes will be awarded for the best three scratch scores.

In addition, there will be a Handicap competition over 36 holes under the same rules and conditions for the following age groups: 12 to 15 years (inclusive) at 31/12/10 and 16 to 17 years (inclusive) at 31/12/10

No player can win more than one prize and only boys whose Home Club is 'Course Owning' and affiliated to Glasgow Golf Union and were born in the years 1993 to 1998 are eligible to play.

The 15 players with the lowest aggregate scores from the Stroke Play Championship and the defending Champion, if eligible, will contest the Match Play Championship over the same course on the dates shown below.

The use of electronic devices is only permitted for the measurement of distance.

Smart casual clothing, including shirts with collars, or jackets and ties must be worn in the Clubhouse and at the Prizegiving. DENIMS OR TRAINERS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
