Conditions of the Competition

The Glasgow City Council has provided a Golf Trophy for competition annually under the following conditions:

1. The competition shall be open to male amateur golfers who are members of recognised golf clubs and have an official Golf Union handicap of not more than **4 strokes from scratch**.
2. Any number of players may enter from any club but the Executive of the Glasgow Golf Union reserves the right to refuse any application for entry and shall also have the right to limit the number of entries. On the entry form each applicant must show their **exact handicap** at the date of application.

7. The trophy shall remain the property of the Glasgow City Council and will be held in the custody of Pollok Golf Club but the name of the winner, as champion of the year, and his club, shall be engraved upon it.
8. The entry fee for each competitor is £15 which should be forwarded with the approved entry form to:

3. The competition shall be by strokes taken over 36 holes and the player with the lowest scratch aggregate of strokes for the two rounds shall be the winner. In the event of a tie for first place, a deciding round of 18 holes will be played. Ties for all other places will be decided on the basis of second round scores.
4. Competitors must be prepared to commence the first round at any time between the hours of 8.00am and 12 noon and any player not present on the tee at the time allocated will be scratched from the competition.
5. The ballot for partners and times of starting will be made on the evening of Wednesday 4th August 2010 and competitors will be notified by post.
6. The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules of the course.

9. Glasgow Golf Union shall organise the competition and their Executive's decision in all related matters shall be final.
10. The closing date for entries is 3rd August 2010 .
11. The use of electronic devices is only permitted for the measurement of distance.

No practice round facilities are available nor are caddies permitted.

It is a condition of acceptance that competitors observe the dress rules of Pollok Golf Club on the course and in the clubhouse.
