**GLASGOW SENIORS'

The Glasgow Seniors' Championship will take place at the Gailes course of the Glasgow Golf Club on Wednesday 12th May 2010, over 18 holes under Stroke Play conditions, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local rules of the Club and the Glasgow Golf Union.

The Competition will be played in 4 classes **based on handicap on the day of the competition.**

Entry is restricted to members, **aged 55 years and over**, of 'course-owning' clubs which are affiliated to the Glasgow Golf Union.

The Competitor with the lowest scratch score will be the Glasgow Golf Union's Senior Champion for 2010.

Trophies will be presented to the competitors with the lowest gross and nett scores.

There will be three handicap prizes in each group.

In the event of a tie for the Championship, a play-off will take place on a date to be arranged by the Executive of the Union. A further tie will be decided on count-back.

There will be no prizegiving ceremony and vouchers will be sent to the various winners.

The presentation of the trophies will be made at the Annual Dinner of the Union.

No competitor is allowed to win more than one prize.

Entry forms can be obtained at your clubhouse, from your club secretary or by downloading from the GGU website (www.glasgowgolfunion.com) and must be returned to I. W. Hunter, Competitions Secretary, Glasgow Golf Union, 81 Seil Drive, Glasgow G44 5DU (Tel 637 9091) **not later than Wednesday 28th April 2010 together with the Entry Fee of £12.**

Applications for entry forms to be sent by post must be accompanied by a SAE.

The Executive reserves the right to refuse any application.

Cheques and postal orders should be made payable to GLASGOW GOLF UNION. **Do not send cash by post.**

Advice will be sent to each competitor of his starting time. This advice will entitle him to the privileges of the Club-house and the Course and must be presented to Union or Club officials on request.

No practice round facilities are available nor are caddies permitted.
