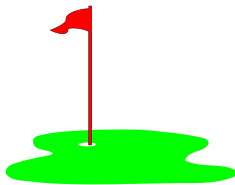
The Summer Meeting (Handicap) Competition of the Glasgow Golf Union will be played, under Stroke Play conditions, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules of the Club and the Glasgow Golf Union, over 18 holes on the Cawder course of Cawder Golf Club on **Sunday, 24th July 2011**, with starting times between the hours of 8.00am and 3.00pm.

Only players of 18 years of age and over whose Home Club is affiliated to the Glasgow Golf Union are eligible to enter. **Entry is restricted to players with handicaps of 7 to 28 inclusive.**

Notification will be sent to each individual player advising him of his starting time and must be presented to the starting official upon arrival.

The letter will entitle the competitor to the privileges of the Course and Clubhouse on the understanding that he will comply with the Club's rules on these matters.

It is a condition of acceptance that all competitors observe the dress rules of the host club on arrival at the Glasgow Golf Union check-in desk and on departure from the Clubhouse, during play, and in the Clubhouse Public Rooms.



Best Nett Scores

1st £150, 2nd £100, 3rd £75, 4th £50.

Class Prizes (1st and 2nd Class)

1st £50, 2nd £40, 3rd £30



In the event of the competition being oversubscribed, there will be a ballot and the higher handicaps will be eliminated. The Competition will then be divided into two classes by handicap.

The Summer Meeting Trophy shall be awarded to the player returning the lowest nett score in either class.

Prizes will be awarded for the four best nett scores (in either class) and, in addition, there will be prizes for the best three nett scores in each class. **NO PLAYER IS PERMITTED TO WIN MORE THAN ONE PRIZE.**

The number and value of the prizes may be varied at the discretion of the Executive, having regard to the number of competitors, equality of scores or any other significant factor.

- (ii) The Executive reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- (iii) Competitors must play from their current handicap on the day of the Competition.
- (iv) In the event of a tie for first place, there will be a play-off over Cawder Golf Club (Cawder Course) on a date to be arranged by Glasgow Golf Union. Ties for all other places will be decided by countback.
- (v) Any dispute will be referred to the Executive of Glasgow Golf Union whose decision is final.
- (vi) Caddies are not permitted.
- (vii) The use of electronic devices is only permitted for the measurement of distance.
