Youths' Team Championship

The competition entry will comprise of teams of three players from invited Areas. Areas may enter more than one team, subject to a total competition entry of 60 not being exceeded. Each team player must be a male amateur golfer between the ages of 16 and 21 (inclusive) on 31st December 2010 with a handicap of 6 or less.

The winners will be the team with the lowest four round total scratch score (aggregate of best two morning & best two afternoon scores). In the event of a tie, the best final round, best two final rounds, etc will be used to decide the final placings. Prizes will be presented to the First and Second teams.

Prizes

First Team £180; Second Team £120

All entry forms, together with the entry fee of £10 per player, should be submitted to the Competitions Secretary at the address shown below by 31st August 2011. Starting times will be notified to players during the week prior to the competition. The Executive of Glasgow Golf Union reserves the right to refuse any entry and will adjudicate on any dispute.

Glasgow Open Amateur Youths' Championship

The Championship is open to amateur golfers between the ages of 16 and 21 years (inclusive) on 31st December 2010 who have a handicap of 6 or less.

All participants in the Team event are automatically entered in the Individual Championship at no additional cost. The maximum number of competitors is limited to 60 players.

Play will be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Ralston Golf Club and Glasgow Golf Union.

Prizes will be presented to the 5 competitors with the best two round scratch aggregate scores.

In addition the Joe Docherty Trophy will be presented to the overall winner. In the event of a tie, the best last round, best last nine holes, etc. will decide.
