## ANNUAL REVIEW

The annual WHS™ Handicap Index review process is to be completed between 1 October and the end of December each year. Specific criteria when completing a handicap review is detailed on pages 98 & 99 of the WHS™ Rules of Handicapping (Appendix D).

### MANAGING TEES FROM VMS

As WHS™ permits scores to be returned from all rated tees throughout the year, there may be occasions when the club must remove tees from play, due to poor weather, poor ground conditions, to protect tees when there is a lack of growth or for maintenance purposes. Several courses do not maintain the fully measured length during the winter months, meaning Acceptable Scores for handicap purposes are not permitted. 
